

JOHNSTOWN: OUTDOOR ADVENTURES

Hike through the **first railroad tunnel built in the U.S.** – the Staple Bend Tunnel. Paddle the Stonycreek River's **longest continuous set of rapids in the eastern U.S.** – 15 Class III-IV rapids in 4 miles. Bike 51 miles on Pennsylvania's **2020 Trail of the Year** – the Ghost Town Trail!

DAY ONE

Hike the Staple Bend Tunnel Trail

Walk through the **first railroad tunnel in the United States!** The tunnel was finished in 1833. **This 2.5-mile trail** connects with the Path of the Flood Trail on the old Allegheny Portage Railroad bed.

Paddle or float down the Stonycreek River

Launch your kayak into the Stonycreek River at Greenhouse Park or one of the various launches and **experience hydraulics aplenty.** Don't want to bring your own kayak? **Coal Tubin'** is the answer for you! They have **guided whitewater rafting** and relaxing **tube floats** down the river.

Stay at Dillweed Bed and Breakfast

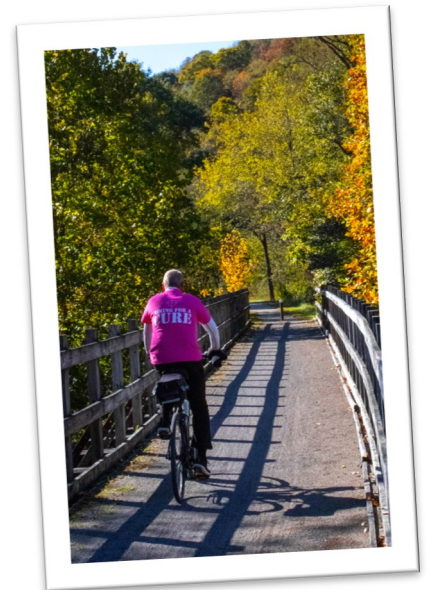
DAY TWO

Shop at the Dillweed Trailside Shop

Spend some time shopping at the Dillweed Trailside Shop before you embark on the Ghost Town Trail. The shop features **homemade soap, country crafts, official Ghost Town Trail logo clothing and souvenirs, gifts** and more!

Bike the Ghost Town Trail

Natural beauty, fascinating historical features and length: The Ghost Town Trail is a **51-mile long 'rails-to-trails' trail.** Named for the long-gone coal-mining communities, the trail flows past **two massive iron furnaces, old coal-loading tipples,** and other **traces of industrial history.** The trail includes a **32-mile main stem** portion from Blacklick, PA to Ebensburg, PA.



Explore Downtown Ebensburg

Ebensburg is the perfect place for **exploring historic attractions, quaint shops, and delicious eateries.** This quaint town **traces its roots back to 1797** when a group of eleven families established a Welsh colony.
