

Flight 93 Tour

Flight 93 is part of the national tragedy of September 11th, 2001. The memorial in Stoystown, PA is highlighted by the Tower of Voices, Wall of Names, and the Visitor Center.

Downtown Johnstown to Flight 93 Memorial

Start out going north on Johns St. toward Roosevelt Blvd./PA-56/PA-403. Turn sharp right onto Roosevelt Blvd./PA-56/PA-403. Continue to follow PA-56 E. Merge onto US-219 S toward Somerset/Windber.

Take the US-30 exit toward Stoystown/Jennerstown. Keep left to take the ramp toward Stoystown.

Turn left onto Lincoln Hwy./US-30 E. Flight 93 National Memorial, 6424 LINCOLN HWY. is on the left.

Flight 93 Memorial to Twin Towers Structural Beam

Start out going northwest on Lincoln Hwy./US-30 W toward Approach Rd. Merge onto US-219 N toward Johnstown.

Merge onto PA-56 W. Turn slight right onto Roosevelt Blvd. Roosevelt Blvd. becomes Power St.

Located at the corner of Power St., and Fifth Avenue is the 9/11 Memorial Twin Towers Structural Beam.

61.5 miles total
