The sojourn offers mostly flat paddling along the borders of Somerset, Cambria, Westmoreland, Indiana, and Armstrong Counties, making it ideal for novice paddlers, as well as those with more experience. The Kiski-Conemaugh is a "drop and pool" river. Water levels can vary greatly depending on time of year and rain fall. If the river is low, you can expect a fair amount of paddling in some sections, and will need to be able to maneuver a boat around river rocks. Designated companion boaters will accompany our group throughout the journey. CVC will transport rental boats.
